Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we continue to assess our situation, it has been determined that it is necessary to switch to e-Learning beginning tomorrow until December 7th. Staffing concerns have ultimately led to this decision. The ability to secure adequate staffing to educate, supervise, clean and feed our students has been an ongoing challenge. We encourage the South Dearborn Community to continue to be vigilant against the spread of Covid-19 by washing hands, wearing a mask, and social distancing when possible. During the break, extensive cleaning will be taking place at all buildings.

Throughout this extended school closure, teachers will utilize Google Meet to hold virtual classroom meetings and instruction Monday through Friday. Teachers will implement the traditional setting schedule currently in place and will communicate meeting times with students through Google Classroom, email, or Class Dojo. If you need additional information, please email your child's teacher or building administrator.

Food service for all students will begin on Wednesday, November 18th at each of our four (4) elementary schools. The pick-up times will be from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm on November 18th and November 30th. Students will be provided with five (5) days of meals during each of the two pick-up days. Meals will consist of both breakfast and lunch. All sports and games, along with academic competitions and fine arts programs will continue as scheduled. Please stay in contact with your coaches and sponsors in the event these activities may be cancelled in the future.

We appreciate everyone's continuing patience as we work through this ever-changing and complex situation. Classes will resume on Monday, December 7th.
